1) Year of establishment, Affiliation of Institution & accreditation details

K. L. E Society's Shri Mrityunjaya College of Arts and Commerce, Dharwad was established on 1st June, 1973 with the blessings of his holiness Mahanth Swamiji of Murughamath, Dharwad. The college is affiliated to Karnatak University, Dharwad since 1993 and our college comes under the fold of UGC 2(f) and 12 (B) since 1994.

The institution was accredited by NAAC with 'B' Grade in 2003 in the First Cycle, with 'B' Grade in 2009 in the second cycle and with 'B+' Grade in the Third Cycle in September, 2016.

2) Courses Offered, Student and Staff Strength

College offers B.A, B.Com & M.Com courses. During the current year, 2020-21, 493 students for B.Com and 500 students for B.A. were admitted. Totally 993 students are studying in Arts and Commerce streams. 39 students were admitted to M.Com II Year. Hence, totally 1032 students are studying in Arts, Commerce streams and M.Com Course.
